Vinification Technique

This popular Vinifera grape is of unknown European origin. Research indicates it could have come from Italy where it is called Primitivo.

These grapes were vinified as a white wine; cold fermented without the skin to maintain fruitiness.

Sensorial Description

Semi-dry, crisp, well balanced, with a clean finish.

ANALYSIS:

Alcohol 12%

Residual sugar (semi-dry) 2.5%

Excellent served well chilled as an aperitif or with fresh fruits and salads.
