

2008 CHAINSAW PINOT NOIR WILLAMETTE VALLEY ESTATE-BOTTLED

In the **Witness Tree Vineyard** we have a number of vineyard blocks that over the years have been grafted over from Chardonnay to Pinot Noir. The **grafting procedure involves** cutting away the existing "head" of the vine **using a chainsaw**, and then splicing the desired grape variety onto the remaining trunk. This leaves a **fully established root-system** to nourish the "**new**" **vine**. We lose one growing season to the procedure, but are back in full production the following year.

2008 Witness Tree Vineyard *Chainsaw* Pinot Noir - the sixth vintage release of this wine - is a composite of lots from various **grafted** sections of our vineyard and includes the Pinot Noir clones 113, 115, 777 as well as our favored Pommard clone.

The wine itself is **packed with bright red fruit** – predominantly **cherry and raspberry** – **and is layered with exotic spices and dark fruits**, all balanced by a firm structure from the wine's natural acidity and tannins. The **2008 Witness Tree Vineyard** *Chainsaw* pairs splendidly with various styles of cuisine – from elegant to spicy – yet provides a delicious cocktail at the beginning of any full-on dinner party.
